





Climbing is a mediation and the reward is a downhill, a reminder of the lesson , 'every up hill will have a down just like in life and it's all about how you face it and take it'

It's been a decade of climbing for some of us and we are glad to share what the paradise island of Sri Lanka has to offer to the world .

From now onwards let's call this Cycling Challenge: **World's End 4XR #ClimbingCocktails** .

The event will happen on the 6th of May 2023 in the picturesque Central hill country of Sri Lanka , known as Nuwa- Eliya ,at 2000 meter altitude . This is the Head Quarters of #PureCeylonTea and is sprinkled with epic categorized climbs , without the snow caps of Alps, Pyrenees , Leh & Ladakh , but rays of sunshine and warm smiles of Sri Lankan hospitality

World's End is the highest motorable road of Sri Lanka and a world famous tourist attraction . It's located on Horton Plain. The plains' vegetation is grasslands blended with montane forest and includes many endemic woody plants . Large herds of Sri Lankan Sambar Deer is a feature as typical mammals. Hence the logo design. The park is also a bird lovers paradise with many species not only endemic to Sri Lanka but restricted to the Horton Plain. The 4 x R stems from the climbs starting with 'R's : Ramboda , Radella, Rendapola , this will get clearer as you keep reading





## HOW IT WORKS

Each Climb will start and finish from the Race HQ , giving riders time to rejuvenate and prepare for the next Climb . In other words you start the ride from race HQ and go down to Randepola time stamp and climb up and come back to Race HQ time stamp go on to do the next climb . If required take a short break and continue . Friends & Family will see the riders 4 times at the Race HQ between the Start & The Finish making World's End 4XR making a unique Cycling Holiday . In other words, family will eat strawberries and drink Ceylon Tea , while riders enjoy their climbing , and cheer them up each time they swing by the Hotel/ Race HQ

## FINISH

Riders who complete all 5 Climbs will get the Worlds End 4XR Finisher medal and plaque and the #ClimbingCocktail Jersey. Relay Teams will get Finisher medals for their achievement

## WIN

Winners in the Solo category will be adjudged based on the segment timing of all 5 climbs under the categories of Climbing Legends
